Country Schedule – Chile

1. **About this Country Schedule**

This Country Schedule is applicable where the Agreement is entered into in the country or territory set forth above. Capitalized terms used in this Country Schedule but not defined have the meanings given in the Agreement.

2. **Governing law and dispute resolution**

The Agreement and any dispute arising from it, whether contractual or non-contractual, will be governed by the law of Chile. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration administered by the Arbitration and Mediation Center at the Chamber of Commerce of Santiago under the CAM Santiago International Commercial Arbitration Rules, in force at the time of the commencement of the arbitration. The number of arbitrators shall be three. The seat of arbitration shall be Santiago. The language to be used in the arbitral proceedings shall be English.
